INFORMATION SYSTEM DUAL B.Sc.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The degree program Information Systems dual B.Sc. combines your studies with vocational training, professional employement, or internships. The focus is on the planning, implementation, and use of IT solutions in companies: Infrastructures, software systems, and IT support of complex business processes are as central here as business management matters relevant for companies.

Computer science and business administration subjects are included in the program curriculum. These are supplemented by specific aspects of information systems.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The modules of the program are divided into three areas: IT & Computer Science, Information Systems, and Business Administration. Practical projects facilitate a more in-depth examination of individual topics. An international approach is possible through an optional semester abroad. Classes take place on a fixed weekday and some Saturdays. Working four days at your company enables continuous integration into the company's practices and processes and the close interlinking of studies and practical experience.

PROSPECTS

The program concludes with the awarding of the academic degree Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.). This degree opens up a wide range of career opportunities. The fields of activity range from operational to strategic responsibilities. In addition, the Bachelor of Science is an accredited and internationally recognized degree that qualifies students to pursue a master's degree.
