

The degree program IT Management on-the-job MSc prepares you to perform management activities in the field of IT. Current and future topics relating to human resource management, project management, and the designing of technical architectures are addressed, as is the exceptional position of IT in companies. You decide whether you would like to specialize in a management-oriented field or a technological field, and select the appropriate major.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The modular degree program is divided into the following areas: Planning, Implementing, Controlling, Leadership, and Application. In the Research & Practical Applications module, specialized subjects are explored in greater depth. Since an international orientation is important to us, you will go an international field trip – a highlight of our master's program. Classes are held all day on Fridays and on some Saturdays. 50% of the courses are taught online and 50% are taught in person in the classroom in Mainz.

PROSPECTS

The degree program concludes with the awarding of the international degree Master of Science (M.Sc.). With this degree, you are eligible to pursue doctoral studies. The curriculum enables you to quickly familiarize yourself with IT-specific problems, to develop suitable solutions in IT projects and team structures, and to take on international management tasks.
